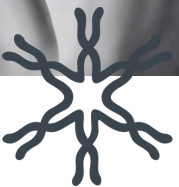

About Telomere Biology Disorders

Telomere Biology Disorders (TBDs) encompass a **group of rare conditions characterized by abnormally short telomeres**. TBDs can manifest in a diverse array of clinical symptoms, including bone marrow failure, pulmonary fibrosis, liver disease, cancer, and other complications.

The mission of Team Telomere is to empower individuals worldwide impacted by Telomere Biology Disorders with information and support services, to advance improved diagnosis through education and advocacy, and to **accelerate the medical and scientific community's research in finding causes, effective treatments, and a path towards a cure**.

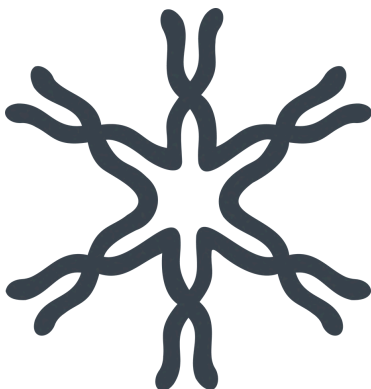
We are making meaningful strides in advocacy, research, and care for those impacted by TBDs. However, as we look ahead, we know there are still mountains to climb.

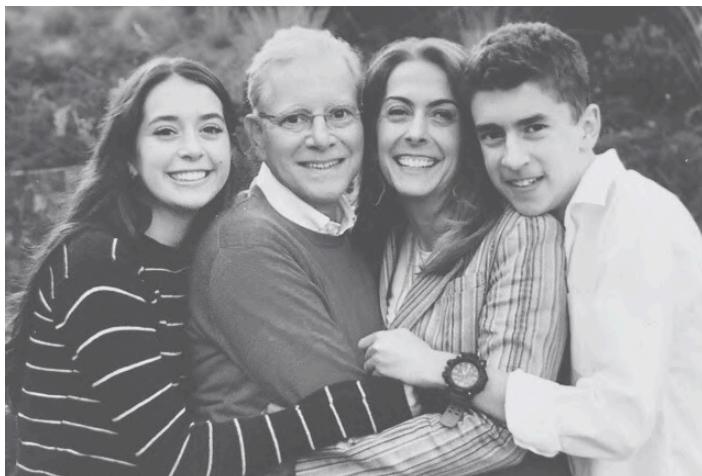
